

e-Watch® Multicast Video Diagnostics using Microsoft® Windows Media Player

This document covers the use of Microsoft Windows Media Player as a simple viewing tool for e-Watch multicast video. This application allows viewing of multiple multicast video streams using the camera address to identify the video stream.

Microsoft Windows 2000 and XP are supported.

Microsoft Media Player versions 9.0 and higher are supported.

This tool requires the installation of the e-Watch video filter, or plug-in, on a Microsoft Windows computer. To obtain the filter, log on to the ViewWatch monitor station. The filter will download after the security logon has been completed.

Start Media Player

Select "**File**", "**Open URL**"

If using SiteWatch 2.6 or earlier, in the Address field enter:

PTCM://239.194.xxx.xxx/s.mpg (To display the SIF video stream)

(OR)

PTCM://239.195.xxx.xxx/q.mpg (To display the QSIF video stream)

If using SiteWatch 3.0 or later, in the Address field enter:

PTAVF2://239.194.xxx.xxx/s.mpg (To display the SIF video stream)

(OR)

PTAVF2://239.195.xxx.xxx/q.mpg (To display the QSIF video stream)

where: xxx.xxx represents the last two octets of the camera's IP address.

The requested video will appear in the video window and will continue until another stream is loaded or the application is closed.

Multiple Media Player windows may be opened simultaneously with Media Player 9.0.
